
## DDs Tips & Tricks Tuesday Half Square Triangles or HST

## Items that you will need.

Ratating Cutting Mat
Rotary Cutter
Quilting Rulers
Marking Pen or Pencil
Iron and Ironing pad
Gernalsewing supplies; pins, thread snips etc
working sewing machine a
matching thread

Half Square triangle Formula

As most quilters work in inches, the below formula is worked out in inches.

HST Finished size x by 2 + 1 = Then cut two squares at this size. For example

HST Finished size is  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

 $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 = 5 + 1" = 6"

So you will cut 1 - 6" square in both background and patterned fabric.
